There were lots of migrants singing away in the hedges including some very loud Wrens which showed themselves very well. Other birders had seen Wheatear, but no luck for us. We soon got away from the motorway noise and spotted all the corvids amongst the wind turbines. No 6 tank was flooded and provided plenty of waterfowl for us but very few waders. Bird of the day was a brief glimpse of a Peregrine. The walk around No 6 tank looked daunting so we turned back just as rain set in. 30 species recorded.
